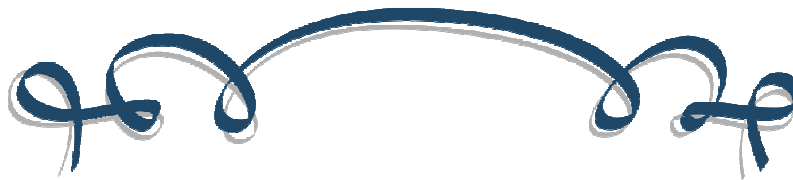
ELEMENTARY EARLY DISMISSALS
