### Message From the Principal/Interim Superintendent

On Tuesday, December 4<sup>th</sup> the qualified voters of the school community voted in support of the proposed merger binding referendum with a 75% majority, passing the proposed referendum with 750 'yes' votes and 248 'no' votes. (WCSD 329 'yes', 199 'no'; ELCSD 421 'yes', 49 'no').

The new Board of Education will have 7 seats and 3 year terms.

I am pleased with the voter turnout. The community has spoken. The Westport Central School District and the Westport community will continue to work together with the Elizabethtown-Lewis Central School District and Community to strive for excellence in the education we provide to our student. I would like to thank all of the community members, employees, and students in both districts who dedicated so much of their time to everything involved in this process. The discussion, though difficult at times, are something that we should all be proud of as a community.

Moving forward – the Elizabethtown-Lewis-Westport Central School District will begin operations on July 1, 2019. Interested candidates for the E-L-W Board of Education can obtain petitions in the next few weeks. Elections will be held in January (date to be determined). Please continue to check the WCS and the ELCS websites for updates involving this process.
