ADVISORY REFERENDUM [STRAW VOTE] - OCTOBER 9, 2018

At their meetings held in September, the WCS and ELCS Board Members voted 'yes' to establish a special vote <u>separately in each district</u> on **Tuesday, October 9, 2018** to see if school district residents are in favor of merging with ELCS into a new school district that would begin operations on July 1, 2019.

The Advisory Referendum [Straw Vote] will be held in the Lobby outside the Bulles Auditorium on Tuesday, October 9 from 12:00 – 8:00 PM. The question that residents will consider, as it will appear on the ballot: "Should the Westport Central School District and the Elizabethtown-Lewis Central School District be joined together as a single district by centralization [merger]?"

If each school district passes their Advisory Referenda respectively, a formal Binding Referendum Vote would be scheduled for **Tuesday**, **December 4**, **2018**.

If the Advisory Referenda vote fails in one of the school districts, the merger process ends.
